- For **Districts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6**
Location: Sutton School, gymnasium—19 Highland Street, Sutton, Québec, J0E 2K0

Polling day: **Sunday, November 7, 2021, from 9:30 a.m. to 8 p.m.**

- For **Districts: 1 and 2**
Location: Royal Canadian Legion—2 Curley Street, Sutton, Québec, J0E 2K0
- For **Districts: 3, 4 and 5**
Location: Sutton School, gymnasium—19 Highland Street, Sutton, Québec, J0E 2K0
- For **District: 6**
Location: Sutton Town Hall, council room—11 Principale Street South, Sutton, Québec, J0E 2K0

4. You will be required to wear a face covering inside the polling places and always maintain a distance of one (1) metre from other voters and election officials.
5. You may bring a pencil or pen with blue or black ink to mark your ballot paper.
6. If you are registered to vote by mail:
 - The returning officer must have received your ballot papers no later than Friday, November 5 at 4:30 p.m.
 - If you are registered to vote by mail and you have not received your ballot papers a few days after you made the request, you can contact the returning officer to obtain new ones. Please note that ballots will be mailed to electors by October 28, 2021.
