



PUBLIC NOTICE

By-Law number 318 coming into force

NOTICE is hereby given by the undersigned that at the regular meeting of March 2, 2022 the Municipal Council adopted By-Law number 318 entitled « By-Law decreeing an expense of \$ 3,019,799.70 and a loan of \$ 3,019,799.70 for the repair of North Sutton Road, between Route 139 and Favreau Road, and for the replacement of 14 culverts on North Sutton, Draper, Vallée Missisquoi and Schweizer Roads »

The purpose of the said by-law is to authorize the granting of a contract, the loan and the necessary expenditures, up to a maximum of \$ 3,019,799.70, in order to carry out work related to the resurfacing of North Sutton Road, between Route 139 and Favreau Road, as well as work related to the drainage of North Sutton, Draper, Missisquoi Valley and Schweizer Roads.

As required by Law, the said By-Law received approval on March 28, 2022, from the ministère des Affaires municipales et de l'Habitation.

Notice is also given that this By-Law comes into force in accordance with the Law and anyone interested and wishing to consult this By-Law may do so at the Municipality's office, 11 Principale Sud Street, Sutton, Quebec, during regular office hours.
