By-Law number 208-5-2022 comes into force

NOTICE is hereby given by the undersigned that at the regular meeting held December 7th, 2022, the Municipal Council adopted the following By-Law:

- **By-law number 208-5-2022 entitled** « By-Law amending By-Law number 208 decreeing the rules of control and budgetary monitoring and delegating certain powers of the Council, in order to modify the delegations and reflect the organizational reality ».

The purpose of the said by-law is to amend the delegations and to reflect the organizational reality of the Town, and more specifically:

- update the table of paragraph 6.1;
- to have the Town Clerk countersign contracts of more than six (6) months in duration.
- to authorize the hiring of unionized staff.

This By-Law comes into force in accordance with the Law and any person interested who wishes to consult the said By-law may do so at the Town's office, 11 Principale Sud Street, Sutton, during regular office hours.
