



CALL FOR TENDERS NUMBER 003-TP-P-23
REPAIR OF THE MISSISQUOI VALLEY ROAD

Bid documents will be available on the Electronic Tendering System (ETS) as of March 10, 2023. Bids will be received at Sutton Town Hall no later than 11:15 a.m. on March 31, 2023.

The Town of Sutton is seeking bids for road rehabilitation. The work includes, but is not limited to, the replacement of one (1) 3500 mm wide x 4000 mm high rectangular culvert with weir and wildlife connectivity crossing, the supply and installation of a 600 mm diameter pipe and the installation of a wildlife connectivity crossing, the insertion of three (3) 450 mm to 600 mm diameter culverts, the repair and stonework of an existing culvert, the cleaning of ditches, pavement structure repairs, paving and marking of the roadway as well as all other related work including various repair and other work necessary for the complete execution of the projected works.

Only contractors who have requested the plans, specifications and tender documents in their name, whose principal place of business is in Quebec, Ontario or New Brunswick, and who are licensed under the Building Contractors Qualification Act, are eligible to bid.

Bids shall be submitted in three (3) copies and shall be accompanied by the following documents:

- A bid bond equal to ten percent (10%) of the bid amount valid for a period of ninety (90) days including a commitment to provide a performance bond and payment for materials and labor set at fifty percent (50%) each of the bid cost.

Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope and deposited at the Sutton Town Hall at 11 Principale Street South, Sutton (QC) J0E 2K0. The deadline for filing a complaint regarding the public agency bidding or award process is March 21, 2023.

Bids will be opened publicly or in accordance with the health guidelines in effect at that time immediately following the closing time at the City Hall office. If a public opening is not possible, a record of the bid opening will be available on the Electronic Tendering System (ETS) after the bid opening.

The Town of Sutton does not undertake to accept the lowest or highest bid or any of the bids received without incurring any obligation or costs of any kind to the bidder(s).

This call for tenders is subject to the Agreement on Trade and Cooperation between Quebec and Ontario (ATCCO), the Agreement on the Liberalization of Government Procurement in Quebec and New Brunswick (AQNB) and the Agreement on Internal Trade (AIT).
