To be eligible for this professional artist and artisan directory, applicants must:

- Be a resident of Sutton or of a town in the Brome-Missisquoi RCM, or have developed a significant artistic practice there;
- Be recognized as a professional artist or artisan as defined by the Quebec ministère de la Culture et des Communications (MCC) Act respecting the professional status of artists in the visual arts, film, the recording arts, literature, arts and crafts and the performing arts, or be an emerging artist or artisan or being in the process of becoming professional, who does not meet the criteria for professional artist or artisan status;
- Provide all required documents.

LIST OF DOCUMENTS TO INCLUDE IN YOUR PORTFOLIO

Application form;

A professional resume;

A visual portfolio containing a maximum of 10 images of previous works;

A list of the images sent in which the works are clearly identified (title, date, techniques, materials);

Press kit and other relevant documents (optional).

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

It is preferable to send us all the information in a single document, in PDF format, identified as follows: *lastname_firstname_application_VDS_2025.pdf* (without spaces).

If you are unable to compile a single PDF document, you can send us documents in WORD format and images in JPG format, with a maximum size of 10 MB.
