



Celebrate Quebec's National Holiday in Sutton on Friday, June 24, starting at 2 p.m. at Goyette-Hill Park

Everyone is invited to come celebrate at Goyette-Hill Park and enjoy the many types of art created in our community. There will be bell peals, patriotic speeches, the raising of the flag, a group mural, lively organized activities, traditional music and fireworks. You'll be sure to have a great time!

The theme for this year's event is *Quebec, de l'art pur* (Quebec, Sheer Art) and art will be everywhere. The visual arts will be represented by a group-made modular mural, and the performing arts by dance, poetry, song and music. Everyone will be able to take part in art activities throughout the day while enjoying the wonderful pure air of Sutton.

Activities will begin around 2 p.m. with inflatable games at the swimming pool. We want to make families feel very welcome, so we've organized a giant group mural, coordinated by a visual artist. Young and old will be invited to add their artistic contributions to the effort. A bit later there will be a big karaoke event where all generations will find something to sing; this will be interspersed with Zumba dancing. The food kiosks will be open from 5 - 7 p.m., followed by a performance with traditional music celebrating the history and culture of Quebec. Then will come a rousing show by the group *Câline de band*, with a break at 10 p.m. for fireworks, after which the music will continue. In short, true to tradition, the people of Sutton will get together outdoors at Parc Goyette-Hill to celebrate the *sheer art* of Quebec culture!
