

The said second draft proposal and the illustration of these zones may be consulted in the offices of the Town Hall, located at 11, South Principale Street, Sutton, Quebec, J0E 2K0, during regular office hours, between 8:30 a.m. and 12 noon and 1:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m., from Monday to Friday.

In order to be valid, a request must:

- a) be received at the offices of the Town Hall located at 11, South Principale Street, Sutton, Quebec, J0E 2K0, no later than **August 25th, 2016**;
- b) clearly indicate the provision that is referred to, the zone from which it originates and identify which zone is targeted by this request;
- c) be signed by at least 12 interested persons in the zone from which it originates or by at least the majority of them if the number of persons interested in the zone from which it originates does not exceed 21.

For the purposes of the present notice, shall be considered an interested party any person who is not disqualified from voting according to article 524 of the *Act Respecting Elections and Referendums in Municipalities* (R.S.Q., chapter E-2.2) and who fulfills the following requirements on **August 1st, 2016**:

- a) be of full age, a Canadian citizen and not be under curatorship;
- b) be a natural person domiciled in a zone where a request may come from, and at least since six months in Québec;
- c) be, at least since 12 months, the owner of an immovable or the occupant of a business establishment, within the meaning of the *Act respecting municipal taxation* (R.S.Q., chapter F-2.1), located in a zone where a request may come from;
- d) in the case of undivided co-owners of an immovable or co-occupants of a place of business be designated by the means of a power of attorney signed by the majority of co-owners or co-occupants, as the one entitled to sign the request on their behalf;
- e) furthermore in order for a legal person to exercise the right to sign a request, the person must be designated among its members, directors and employees, by resolution, as someone who, on **August 1st, 2016**, is of full age, a Canadian citizen and is not under curatorship.

All of the provisions of the second draft proposal for which no valid request has been received shall be included in a resolution that does not have to be approved by qualified voters.
