



PUBLIC NOTICE

TO INTERESTED PERSONS HAVING THE RIGHT TO SIGN A REQUEST TO PARTICIPATE IN A REFERENDUM

SECOND DRAFT PROPOSAL RELATING TO AUTHORIZING UNDER BY-LAW NUMBER 220 (SCAOPI) A « ROOMING HOUSE » TO LODGE THE EMPLOYEES AND TO INCLUDE A LAUNDRY SPACE, WHICH IS TO BE LOCATED AT 297 MAPLE STREET ON A PROPERTY MADE UP OF LOTS 5 608 544 AND 5 608 615 OF THE CADASTRE OF QUEBEC (PPCMO2018-90093).

Notice is given to those interested persons and organizations having the right to sign a request to participate in a referendum.

Following the public consultation meeting held on December 3rd, 2018, the Town of Sutton's Municipal Council adopted, at the regular Council meeting held on December 3rd, 2018, by resolution number 2018-12-529, the second draft resolution authorizing a "rooming house" to lodge the employees and to include laundry space, which is to be located at 297 Maple Street on a property made up lots 5 608 544 and 5 608 615 of the cadastre of Quebec (PPCMOI2018-90093).

This second draft proposal is to authorize that no main household be present on the premises of the « rooming house ».

This second draft resolution contains provisions that can be the subject of a request by interested persons asking that it be submitted for their approval according to the *Act respecting Elections and Referendum in Municipalities*.

This second draft resolution includes amendments when compared to the first draft resolution.

A request pertaining to these provisions may come from zone C-09 and its contiguous zones, namely H-07, H-36, H-38, REC-02 and REC-03.

The approximate boundaries of the zones in question and the contiguous zones mentioned in this notice are the following: :

To the north by Poissant road and des Montagnais road. To the south by Maple road. To the west by Montembault road and de l'Esquer road. To the east by a sector bounded by the developpement on both sides of Bernier Street.

Copies of the second draft proposal, the illustration of the zones and information determining which interested persons have the right to sign a request, can be consulted and are available without fees at the Sutton Town Hall, located 11 South Principale Street, between 8:30 a.m. and 12:00 (noon) and from 1:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m., from Monday to Friday.

To be valid, the request must be:

1. Received at the Sutton Town Hall, located at 11 South Principale Street, Sutton, JOE 2KO, at the latest on **January 31st, 2019;**
2. Clearly indicate the provision that is referred in the zone from which it originates and identify which zone is targeted by this request;
3. Be signed by at least 12 interested persons in the zone from which it originates or by at least the majority of them if the number of persons interested in the zone from which it originates does not exceed 21.

Any provision set out in the second draft proposal that is not subject to a valid request may be included in a resolution that will not require approval from qualified voters.
