



SUTTON AFFORDABLE HOUSING PROJECT

What is the Sutton Affordable Housing project?

This project is managed by the not-for-profit Les Habitations abordables Sutton and is financed by the AccèsLogis Québec program in partnership with the Town of Sutton. The goal of the project is to offer affordable, new, quality housing, particularly for families.

The new construction, in two buildings, will be built in Sutton, on South Principale Street, next to the CPE (opposite Kubota). The move-in date is planned for October 2020. The project is intended to provide:

- A total of 18 units both 4 1/2 (2 bedrooms) and 5 1/2 (3 bedrooms);
- Some units with a universal design making them usable by people with disabilities;
- A dynamic, community-based environment within walking distance of the village and services;
- Possibility of subsidy for low-income households.

How can you show your interest in occupying one of the affordable housing units?

The moving-in date is not expected before October 2020 but the project is at the stage where it is **very important** to **express your interest now** by completing and returning the *Housing Reservation Request* form **by 4pm, June 12, 2019** . Here are the steps to follow:

- Ask for a copy of the form at the Sutton Town Hall;
- Fill out the form by following the attached instructions;
- If you need help filling out the form call the Volunteer Center (CAB Sutton) 450 538-1919 to make an appointment with Jessie (Family Resource) or Caroline (Resource 50+);

- Return the completed form, by hand, to the Town Hall no later than **4pm, June 12, 2019**.
