### BY-LAW NUMBER 251-03-2020 COMES INTO FORCE

**PUBLIC NOTICE** is hereby given by the undersigned Town Clerk:

**THAT** By-Law number By-Law number 251-03-2020 entitled « By-Law modifying By-Law number 251 regarding permits and certificates, as amended, in order to integrate standards for connections to municipal services and to modify the boundaries of the mountain area and the village core as presented in annexes 1 and 2 » was adopted on December 7, 2020, has received the necessary approvals required by law, and the certificate of conformity was issued by the Brome-Missisquoi MRC on February 16<sup>th</sup>, 2021.

The purpose of this By-Law is to modify standards for connections to municipal services in the mountain and village core sectors and to modify boundaries of the mountain area and the village core in order to outline the territory being presently serviced.

This By-Law came into force on February 16<sup>th</sup>, 2021.
