2 Look at the old photos of the Sisters of the Presentation of Mary convent on the panel; name three differences between it then and now.

Name three differences: The verandah along the side; alcove and statue on front wall; front entrance and stairways; annexe building in back; driveway; cross at the roof peak

3 There is one gravestone at St. André's Cemetery that is carved in a unique shape; what is it?

A heart or a log (or an urn)

Draper Hill

4 What did Draper Hill copper miners use to see when working in the dark mining shafts?

Candles with light reflectors attached

Potash

7 If you were a mason, you would use which raw material to build a house?

Stone

8 Which mode of transportation completely changed the way of life for people in Sutton?

Train

9 How many barns can be found at the Olmstead farm today?

Two, plus other smaller outbuildings (that were used as dairy shed and henhouse)
