Tender documents will be available on the electronic call for tenders (SEAO) website from July 12, 2021. Bids will be received at Sutton Town Hall no later than at 11 a.m. on August 12, 2021.

The City of Sutton is requesting bids for the repair of part of Scenic Road and for drainage work on Alderbrooke Road. Without being limited to it, the work briefly includes the replacement of twelve (12) culverts varying between 450mm and 1650mm in diameter, the repair of one end of the culvert, the cleaning of two (2) culverts of 450mm in diameter, spraying of the existing paving, the amendment, the shaping of the sprayed material, the paving and the resurfacing of the shoulders over approximately 2.6 km, as well as all other related works including various repair works and others necessary for the complete execution of the planned works.

Only contractors who have requested plans, specifications and tender documents on their behalf, whose principal place of business is located in Quebec, Ontario or New Brunswick, and who hold a license under the Law on the professional qualification of building contractors.

Bids must be submitted in three (3) copies and be accompanied by the following documents:

- a bid bond equal to ten percent (10%) of the amount of the bid, valid for a period of sixty (60) days;
- a letter of intent from an insurance company providing a performance bond as well as payment for materials and labor. These guarantees must be equal to fifty percent (50%) each of the cost of the tender, valid for a period of sixty (60) days.

Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope and dropped off at Sutton Town Hall at 11 Principale St. South, Sutton (QC) J0E 2K0.

The deadline for filing a complaint regarding the procurement or award process for public bodies is July 28, 2021.

Tenders will be opened publicly or according to the health directives in effect at that time immediately after the closing time at the Hôtel-de-Ville office. If a public opening is not possible, a record of the opening of tenders will be available on the Electronic Tendering System (SEAO) after the opening of tenders.

The Town of Sutton does not undertake to accept either the lowest or the highest or any of the bids received without incurring any obligation or cost of any kind towards the bidder (s).

This call for tenders is subject to the Trade and Cooperation Agreement between Quebec and Ontario (ACCQO), to the Agreement on the Liberalization of Public Procurement in Quebec and New Brunswick (AQNB) and to the 'Agreement on Internal Trade (AIT).
