NOTICE is hereby given that the Municipal Council of the Town of Sutton wishes to adopt *By-law number 317 entitled « Code of ethics and good conduct of elected officers of the Town of Sutton »* at the regular meeting of February 2, 2022, at 7:30 p.m., the whole in accordance with articles 4 to 13 of the *Municipal Ethics and Good Conduct Act*. Depending on the pandemic situation and the decrees or ministerial orders in effect on February 2, 2022, this regular meeting will be held in person at the Town Hall of Sutton, located at 11 Principale Sud Street, or behind closed doors by videoconference, in which case the meeting will be broadcasted on the You Tube channel of the Town of Sutton: https://www.youtube.com/channel/UCho_cik7f5pK2CjJ0f5dxSA.

Notice of motion was given at the regular meeting of January 19, 2022, and the draft by-law was tabled at the same meeting.

The purpose of By-Law number 317 is to set out the Town's main ethical values and the rules of conduct that should guide the conduct of a person as a member of Council, a committee or commission of the Town or, in his or her capacity as a member of Council of the Town, of another organization.
