

## MAYOR'S REPORT ON THE 2021 FINANCIAL REPORT AND THE INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

Dear fellow citizens,

I am pleased to present the financial report of the Town of Sutton for the year ended December 31, 2021, including the report of the independent auditor, Raymond Chabot Grant Thornton.

At the outset, I would like to point out that the auditor has issued an unqualified opinion that provides unqualified assurance that the financial statements present fairly, in all material respects, the financial position of the Town as at December 31, 2021.

You will note that 2021 revenues have increased to \$13,199,183, a 9.8% growth over the adopted budget. This growth is mainly due to the increase in transfer taxes of \$843,011, which is greater than anticipated, the increased grant from the MTQ for road maintenance of \$213,257, and the revenue received from RECYC-Quebec, which is \$77,188 more than anticipated. Expenses are \$11,163,741, a decrease of 4.1% over budget, while allocations total \$80,293, leaving a surplus of \$1,955,150 for fiscal year 2021.

Total reserve funds as of December 31, 2021 are \$4,174,158.
