



## PUBLIC NOTICE

### CHARTER OF THE FRENCH LANGUAGE FILING OF A NOTICE RELATING TO THE DEMOLINGUISTIC DATA OF THE TOWN OF SUTTON

**PUBLIC NOTICE** is hereby given by the undersigned Town Clerk that the Town of Sutton has received a *Notice of Demolinguistic Data of the Town of Sutton* (hereinafter "Notice").

This Notice dated December 12, 2022 and received by the Town on December 13, 2022 states, in summary, as follows:

- According to the 2021 Statistics Canada census data, 26.8% of the residents of the Town of Sutton declared English as their mother tongue, which is less than the majority required by section 29.1 of the *Charter of the French Language*.
- To maintain its recognition, the Town of Sutton must adopt a resolution to this effect on or before April 12, 2022.
