

MAYOR'S REPORT ON THE 2022 FINANCIAL STATEMENTS AND THE INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

Dear fellow citizens,

I am pleased to present the Town of Sutton's financial report for the year ended December 31, 2022, including the report of the independent auditor, Raymond Chabot Grant Thornton.

As a preamble, I would like to point out that the auditor has issued an opinion without reservation which provides with no restrictions assurance that the financial statements present, in all significant aspects, the Town's financial position as of December 31, 2022.

You will note that revenues for 2022 have increased to \$14,228,039, representing a growth of 8,2% over the adopted budget. This growth is mainly due to an increase in transfer duties of \$480,629, revenues received from RECYC-QUÉBEC of \$88,647 higher than forecast, the use of \$140,877 of the sums collected for connection fees to the mountain sector aqueduct network, other interest income and services rendered totalling \$136,728 higher than forecast. Expenses totalled \$14,488,863, a 5.9% decrease compared to the budget, while elements of reconciliation for tax purposes totalled \$2,317,002, leaving a surplus of \$2,056,179 for 2022 financial year.

Total reserves amount to \$4,269,347 as of December 31, 2022.
