## By-Law number 325 coming into force

**NOTICE** is hereby given by the undersigned that at the regular meeting of May 3, 2023, the Municipal Council adopted By-Law number 325 entitled « By-Law decreeing an expense of \$800,000 and a loan of \$800,000 for rehabilitation work on the aqueduct on the northern section of Western Street ».

The purpose of this by-law is to authorize the awarding of a contract, the loan and the necessary expenditures, up to a maximum of \$800,000, in order to carry out work related to the rehabilitation of the aqueduct on the northern section of Western Street, as announced in the 2023-2024-2025 PTI.

As required by law, said By-Law was approved by the ministère des Affaires municipales et de l'Habitation on June 22, 2023, up to a maximum amount of \$ 684,194. If necessary, following the receipt and breakdown of the tenders, the Council may adopt a resolution to obtain further approval from the Ministry.

Notice is also given that this By-Law comes into force in accordance with the Law and anyone interested and wishing to consult this By-Law may do so at the Municipality's office, 11 Principale Sud Street, Sutton, Quebec, during regular office hours.
