By-Law number 329 coming into force

NOTICE is hereby given by the undersigned that at the regular meeting of October 4, 2023, the Municipal Council adopted By-Law number 329 entitled « By-Law decreeing an expense of \$ 534,656 and a loan of \$ 534,656 for securing, supply and installation of generators on the Town's aqueduct buildings ».

The purpose of this by-law is to authorize the awarding of a contract, the loan and the necessary expenditures, up to a maximum of \$ 534,656, to carry out work related to securing, supplying and installing generators on the Town's aqueduct buildings, as announced in the ITP 2023-2024-2025.

As required by Law, the said By-Law received approval on November 10th, 2023, from the ministère des Affaires municipales et de l'Habitation.
