

PUBLIC NOTICE

BY-LAW NUMBER 251-6-2023 COMES INTO FORCE

NOTICE is hereby given by the undersigned that at the regular meeting held November 1st, 2023, the Municipal Council adopted the following By-Law:

• By-law number 251-6-2023 entitled « By-law amending By-Law number 251 relating to permits and certificates, as amended, in order to include provisions regarding lodging establishments in principal and tourist residences ».

The purpose of said by-law is:

- 1. to integrate provisions relating to lodging establishments in principal residences and tourist residences on the territory of the Town of Sutton;
- 2. to require confirmation, for any site not serviced by the municipal aqueduct system, that the well drilled on the property is capable of supplying drinking water of sufficient quality and quantity to serve the main building and the proposed use.

The said By-Law came into force on November 22, 2023, when the certificate of conformity was issued by the Brome-Missisquoi MRC.

This By-Law comes into force in accordance with the Law and any person interested who wishes to consult the said By-Law may do so at the Town's office, 11 Principale Sud Street, Sutton, during regular office hours.
