



**PUBLIC NOTICE TO IMMOVABLE OWNERS AND OCCUPANTS OF A BUSINESS
ESTABLISHMENT
MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS**

By this public notice, Me Geneviève Bonnichon, the returning officer, announces the following to the owners of an immovable and the occupants of a business establishment.

1. You may have the right to vote if you are the owner of an immovable or if you are the occupant of a business establishment in the municipality for at least 45 days on November 2, 2025.
2. To be eligible, you must be 18 years of age or older on polling day and have the Canadian citizenship on November 2, 2025. You must not be under curatorship or deprived of your election rights on that date.
3. To exercise your voting right, you must submit the appropriate document:
 - An application for entry if you are the sole owner of an immovable or sole occupant of a business establishment.
 - If you are one of the co-owners of co-occupants of an immovable or a business establishment, a power of attorney designating one person among you, who will be entered on the list.

You must submit the completed form by email or in person at the address indicated below.

4. For the application to be valid for the current election, you must submit your form no later than October 21, 2025, at 10 : 00 p.m.

The application for entry on the list of electors or the power of attorney remains valid until it is replaced or withdrawn. If you want to replace or withdraw an existing application for entry or a power of attorney, please contact the returning officer.

5. **You will have the opportunity to vote by mail.** To do so, you must submit a request to the election chair no later than October 21, 2025. To make a written request, you can fill out the section of the form that allows you to register on the electoral roll described in point 3 above. Your request to vote by mail will only be valid for the event in question.
